Here at Tove Valley FC we have a series of policies in place which we follow to ensure all of our players can raise any concerns they have with the clubs administrative team, which can be done in confidence and anonymously, with all issues actioned when raised by any individual.

We have both a **Club Welfare Officer** and **Player Welfare Officer** to ensure there are multiple points of contact within our small club should any issues arise.

Our CWO, Jack, is also the Chairman and Head Coach of the First team, holding a valid DBS certificate and is a Level 1 Qualified FA Coach with experience in managing adults and children across multiple teams. He is the clubs First Aid and Safeguarding Officer, and shall be ensuring your child is safe and enjoyable football at all times.

Both Jack and Max are on hand if either you or your child has any problems that you would like to raise to the club, and are easily contactable either by message, call or at the club email clubwelfare@tovevalleyfc.co.uk, as well as in person at the sessions. The club and both officers are committed to upholding the promise to address any comments you may have and will ensure help is provided until you are satisfied with the clubs adjustments.
